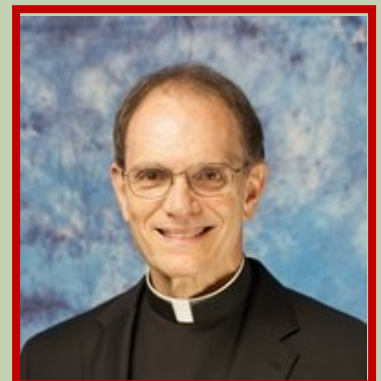

He is a certified Spiritual Director through the Archdiocesan Spirituality Center.

Fr. Joe was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of New Orleans in 1994. He has served the church in several parishes and diocesan administrative positions and as Chaplain for the St. Thomas More Catholic Lawyers Association, Engaged Encounter, Catholic Men’s Fellowship and Rachel’s Vineyard. Since 2007, Fr. Joe’s primary ministry has been as Director of Spiritual Formation and Spiritual Director for the men being formed as priests at Notre Dame Seminary. He regularly gives retreats, missions and days of prayer on the spiritual life.
